PHAIDRA in Serbia

- PHAIDRA.BG – [University of Belgrade](#)
 - Installed on March 2011; production phase November 2011, cca 2100 objects
- PHAIDRA.NI – [University of Niš](#)
 - Installed on September 2011; production phase June 2012, 300 objects
- PHAIDRA.KG – [University of Kragujevac](#)
 - Installed on September 2011; still test phase

PHAIDRA in Montenegro

- PHAIDRA.ME – [University Montenegro](#)
 - Installed on May 2011; officially promoted at Montenegro Book fair on May 2012;
 - [Phaidra Service](#) established

PHAIDRA in Bosnia

- Implementation of Creative Common License v. 3.0 Serbia for all WB Phaidras

- Promoting materials > flyers, posters etc.
- June 2011. - first promotion of the system to faculty librarians (50 librarians)
- June - September 2011 – installation of PHAIDRA.BG Service Pages for 3 Serbian universities

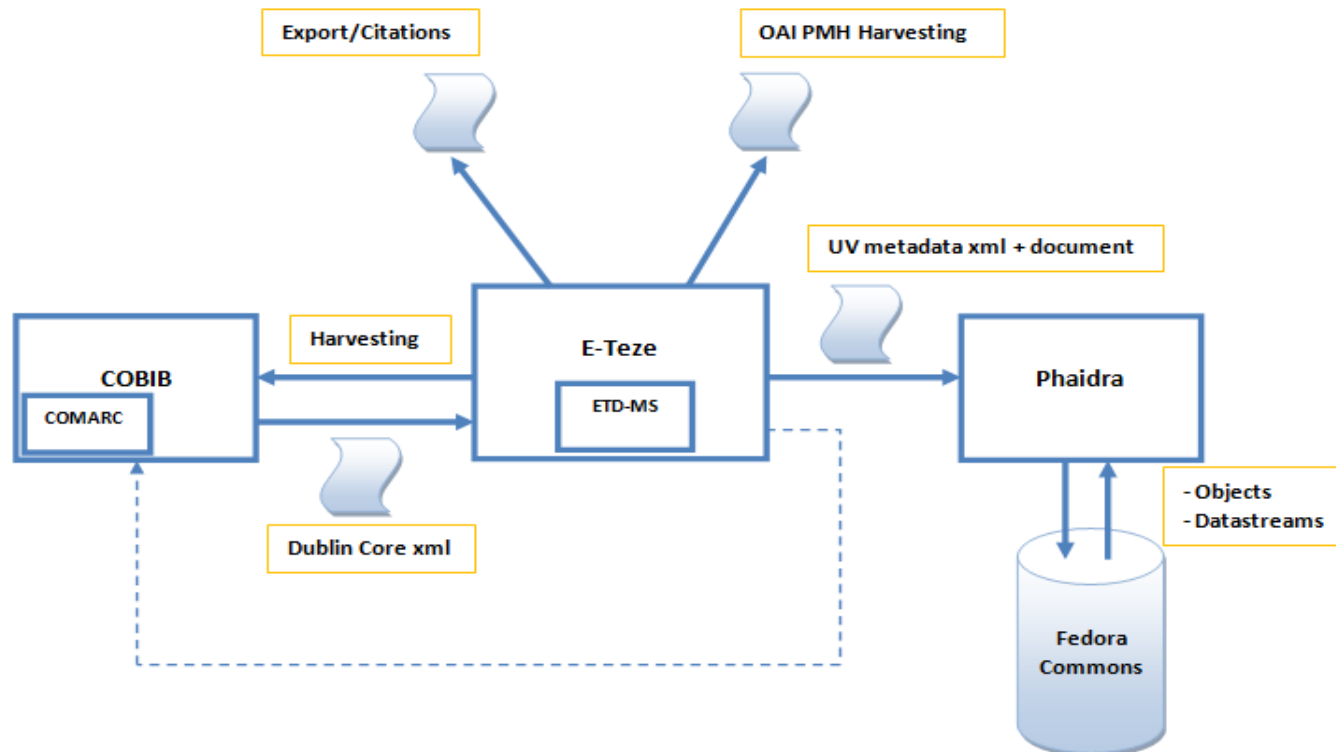
Training courses


